

Yoro Valley is a valley formed by the Yoro River, which flows from Awamata, Otaki Town, Isumi County, Chiba Prefecture to Asaohara, Ichihara City.

You can enjoy azaleas and wisteria in spring, and autumn leaves in autumn.

It is famous for autumn leaves, but you can also enjoy various leisure activities such as mountain stream fishing and barbecue.

In 2007, it was selected as one of Japan's top 100 geological features.
